IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for Reconstruction of Leavitt Hall, Maine Maritime Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Leavitt Hall; reconstruction of. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Maritime Academy the sum of \$580,600 to reconstruct Leavitt Hall. Such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
