AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Expand Homemaker Services in the Department of Health and Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the General Fund the sum of \$101,000 to provide for the expansion of its homemaker services. The breakdown of expenditures is as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above funds will generate federal funds of approximately \$60,620 for 1967-68 and \$62,400 for 1968-69. The figures for "all other expenses" include \$20,000 for each fiscal year for direct grants to nongovernmental agencies to assist them in developing homemaker services. These funds for direct grants to nongovernmental agencies are not federally matchable. The balance of needed appropriations both for personal services and other expenditures will be matched by federal funds of approximately \$113,020 for the biennium.
