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**AN ACT Relating to Definition of Practice of Professional Engineering.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 32, § 1251, sub-§ 3, amended.** Subsection 3 of section 1251 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

3. **Practice of professional engineering.** The term "practice of professional engineering" shall be held to mean any professional service, such as consultation, **surveys**, investigation, evaluation, planning, design or responsible supervision of construction in connection with any public or private utilities, structures, buildings, machines, equipment, processes, works or projects, wherein the public welfare or the safeguarding of life, health or property is concerned or involved, when such professional service requires the application of engineering principles and data.
