AN ACT Limiting Outdoor Advertising of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 5, amended. Section 5 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other law, outdoor advertising of alcoholic liquor is unlawful, except that each licensee may be permitted a sign or signs, totaling not more than 6 square feet of surface, indicating that alcoholic liquor is served in his place of business.
