AN ACT Providing for Noncommercial Lobster Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 4404, sub-§ 5, amended. Subsection 5 of section 4404 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

5. License fee. The fee for a lobster and crab fishing license **or a non-commercial lobster license** is \$10 which the applicant shall enclose with his application.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 4404, sub-§ 5-A, additional. Section 4404 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 5-A, as follows:

5-A. Noncommercial lobster license. A noncommercial lobster license shall be issued to a person who meets the residence requirements of subsection 4. The license entitles the holder to catch lobsters on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays for his own use, but not for sale. No person holding such a license shall at the same time hold a commercial lobster license of any kind.
