SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 457, L.D. 631, Bill, "An Act Creating County Commissioner Districts."

Amend said Amendment by striking out in the 6th line of the 6th paragraph the underlined words "<u>Indian Res.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words '<u>Indian Island Voting</u> <u>District</u>'

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end the following:

'Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line of the 58th paragraph of that part designated "<u>\$105-B.</u>" of section 2 (4th in L. D. 631) the following underlined words "<u>Indian Reservation</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following '<u>Indian Township Voting District</u>'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined abbreviations and figure "<u>No. 14 Plt.</u>, " in the 3rd line of the 59th paragraph of that part designated "<u>§105-B.</u>" of section 2 (same in L. D. 631) the following: '<u>Pleasant Point</u> Voting District,'
