HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 265, L.D. 646, Bill, "An Act  
Authorizing One to Two-year Sentences to Certain  
County Jails."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 the  
following underlined paragraph:

'The county in which the defendant is sentenced shall  
reimburse the county wherein the jail may be located to which  
the defendant is sentenced and committed as provided by  
section 1705, provided that in the event of a change of venue  
for the trial, the county where the trial was initiated shall  
reimburse the county wherein the jail may be located to which  
the defendant is sentenced and committed.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 6.
