AN ACT to Restrict the Use of L. P. Gas Containers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2463, additional. Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2463, as follows:

§ 2463. Restriction on use of containers; penalty

No person, firm or corporation, other than the owner and those authorized by the owner to do so, shall sell, fill, refill, deliver or permit to be delivered or use in any manner any liquefied petroleum gas container, receptacle or regulating equipment for any gas, compound or for any other purpose whatsoever. Whoever shall violate this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500.
