AN ACT Relating to Fee for a Master Electrician's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 1203, amended. The first sentence of section 1203 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 8 of chapter 385 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The following applicants for license shall present to the executive secretary of the board a written application for examination and license, containing such information as the board may require, accompanied by the required fee of \$25, or **\$12.50 if the applicant is over 65 years of age**, for a master electrician's license, \$10 for a journeyman's license and \$5 for a type S journeyman's license.
