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**RESOLVE, to Increase Retirement Benefit for Susie H. Yeaton of Harrington.**

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**Susie H. Yeaton; retirement benefit increased. Resolved:** That the retirement benefit now being paid to Susie H. Yeaton of Harrington under the Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 101, and under the Resolves of 1961, chapter 69, be increased by the amount of \$50 per month.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Yeaton is a former school teacher, now 85 years of age. Because of serious illness, she was obliged to retire after teaching 27  $\frac{1}{3}$  years. Miss Yeaton is a diabetic, under doctor's care. Her medicines, food and medical care are expensive and she is in great need of financial assistance during her few remaining years.
