**AN ACT Relating to Eligibility for Office of Bank Commissioner.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 9, § 1, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 1 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No person shall be eligible for said office unless he shall have had at the time of his appointment at least 7 years practical experience in one or more of the following capacities, as an executive officer ~~director or trustee of a bank or loan and building association doing business in Maine~~ **trust company, mutual savings bank or national bank, located in this or another state**, or as an employee in the banking department of this or some other state, or as an employee of a federal examining authority charged with examining financial institutions.
