IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Vote of Mayor of Lewiston on Board of Finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 3, amended. Section 3 of Article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 146 of the private and special laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 3. Chairman. The mayor shall be ex officio the chairman of the board of finance and the authority of said mayor to act and vote shall be coextensive with the 4 other members of said board of finance but shall have no vote therein except for the purpose of breaking a tie.
