AN ACT Clarifying Law Relating to Failure of School Bus Operator to Stop at Railroad Crossing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2011, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 7th paragraph of section 2011 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The operator of any school bus failing to so stop shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200; and his driver's license permit to operate any school bus shall be suspended by the Secretary of State for a period of not less than 2 years.
