IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. Hazel Costigan, of Milford, for Well Damage.

Mrs. Hazel Costigan; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Mrs. Hazel Costigan of Milford, for damage to her well caused by highway construction on Route 2.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Chemical examination of Mrs. Costigan's well shows a high content of salt. Mrs. Costigan is almost bedridden with arthritis and a bad heart. The Highway Commission took a piece of her land for highway construction and the snow from the highway was then piled on top of her well. The water is now unsafe for domestic consumption.
