**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Towns of Thomaston, Warren and Windham for
Fire and Municipal Protection Services for the State.**

Certain towns reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$3,500 to be paid to the following towns for fire and municipal services for state buildings, as follows:

Thomaston,	\$1,750;
Warren,	875;
Windham,	875.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Inasmuch as the State of Maine is dependent upon the Towns of Thomaston, Warren and Windham for fire protection of its various buildings and the towns must plan and expend moneys for such service, it is essential that the State of Maine reimburse these towns within which state-owned buildings exist in the amount proportionate to the insured evaluation of said property in comparison to that otherwise assessed on taxable property for fire and municipal protection.
