## AN ACT Relating to Definition of the Practice of Barbering.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 32, § 301, sub-§ 1, ¶ C, amended.** Paragraph C of subsection 1 of section 301 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**C.** Singeing, dyeing, tinting, bleaching or shampooing the hair or applying cosmetic preparations to the hair, scalp, face, neck or upper part of the body; such dyeing, tinting or bleaching shall not be practiced unless the barber  $\overrightarrow{or}$  apprentice barber has taken a course with a minimum of  $\overrightarrow{75}$  hours in such practices, approved by the board;
