AN ACT Relating to Term of Members on Board of Barbers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 351, amended. The 3rd sentence from the end of the first paragraph of section 351 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Thereafter, each of the barber members of the board shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, for a term of 3 years and until his successor is appointed and qualified. No person after serving 2 full terms as a member of the board shall be eligible for reappointment.
