COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 496, L.D. 709, Bill, "An Act Providing for Hunting Moose in Certain Portions of Aroostook County for 1967 and 1968."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the Title the words "Aroostook County" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Northern Deer Hunting Zone'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the catchline and first paragraph of that part designated "§2355-B" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§2355-B. Open season on moose in certain portions of northern deer hunting zone

There shall be an open season not to exceed 5 days on moose in certain portions of the northern deer hunting zone. Said portions and open season shall be determined by the commissioner.'
