### AN ACT Describing Boundaries of Merrymeeting Bay Game Sanctuary.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2101, amended.** That part of section 2101 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, which relates to Merrymeeting Bay Game Sanctuary is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**Merrymeeting Bay Game Sanctuary:** A game sanctuary shall be established in Merrymeeting Bay bounded and described as follows: Beginning on the westerly side at an iron stake at the high water mark at the southeast corner of the Inland Fish and Game property; thence northerly and easterly by high water mark, to the south side of the Abbogadassett River Bridge; thence along the south side of the bridge easterly to high water mark; thence continuing along the high water mark easterly and southerly to a red stake, on the east side of the Abbogadassett River at high water mark, which stake marks the boundary line of land of Ezra Stevens and Ransom P. Kelly; thence easterly by this line to land of Blair heirs; thence southerly and easterly and northerly by line of Blair heirs to land of one Perkins; thence easterly, northerly and westerly by property line of said Perkins and R. Kelly to the east side of Stevens Road; thence northerly by the east side of Stevens Road to the northern road limits of Browne Point Road; thence easterly along the northern road limits of said Browne Point Road to land of Erle Browne; thence southerly by the property line of said Browne and R. Kelly to an iron pipe at the southwest corner of the Erle Browne property; thence southerly from the iron pipe to the support tower of the southern high tension line; thence easterly by said high tension line to a red stake at high water mark on the eastern shores of the Kennebec River; thence southerly by high water mark to the red stake on the tip of Elliott's Point (Lat. 43° 59' 31.5" North—Long. 69° 49' 34" West); thence westerly to the point of beginning.
