**AN ACT Relating to Fishing Without License for Patients at Veterans
Administration Hospital.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2301, sub-§ 1, repealed and replaced. Subsection 1 of section 2301 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 11 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

1. Patients at Veterans Administration Center authorized to fish without license. The commissioner is authorized to permit in-patients at the Veterans Administration Hospital at Togus to fish without license in the inland waters within a 25-mile radius of Togus. Patients not under the direct supervision of hospital staff or volunteer supervisors shall have in their possession while fishing a valid pass issued by the Veterans Administration Hospital.
