SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 505, L. D. 718, Resolve,
Regulating Fishing in Third Chase Pond, Aroostook County.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following Title: 'Resolve, Regulating
Fishing in Fish River Falls, Aroostook County, and Long Pond,
Kennebec County.'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out everything
after the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Fishing in Fish River Falls regulated.

Resolved: That there shall be no fishing in Fish
River Falls, T. 13, R. 8, Aroostook County, from the falls to
a point 200 feet below the falls from time of ice out to June
15th of each year; and be it further

Fishing in Long Pond of Belgrade Lakes, Rome and Belgrade
Townships, Kennebec County.

Resolved: That there shall be no bag limit on white
perch in Long Pond of Belgrade Lakes, Rome and Belgrade
Townships, Kennebec County.'
