STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting the Obtaining of Transportation on Ski Lift Without Payment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1623, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1623, to read as follows:

§ 1623. Obtaining transportation on ski lift

Whoever, with intent to cheat or defraud shall, by any false representation, false pretense or privy or false token, wrongfully obtains, or attempts to obtain, transportation upon any ski tow, ski lift or passenger tramway without paying the established charge therefor, and whoever, while being transported upon any ski tow, ski lift or passenger tramway, or after being transported and while still remaining on the premises provided for skiing, willfully refuses on demand to pay the established charge, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both.
