**RESOLVE, Permitting R. Dean Seguin of South Paris to Take the Examination
for Admission to Practice Law.**

R. Dean Seguin; authorized to take examination. Resolved: That the Board of Examiners for the Examination of Applicants for Admission to the Bar is authorized and directed to permit R. Dean Seguin of South Paris to take the examination for admission to the bar in 1968 or thereafter, notwithstanding any requirements necessary under the Revised Statutes, Title 4, chapter 17, subchapter I, with full and equal opportunity to enjoy the privileges and rights accorded candidates who otherwise qualify for examination by virtue of having sufficiently fulfilled the aforesaid requirements.
