AN ACT Providing Funds for Support of Civil Air Patrol.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 6, § 46, additional. Title 6 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 46, to read as follows:

§ 46. Civil Air Patrol

The commission (Aeronautics) shall administer any funds made available by the Legislature to the Civil Air Patrol, which patrol shall expend such funds as in its best judgment would most effectively carry out its purposes and objectives.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Aeronautics Commission the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purpose of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
