IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for Associate Degree in Nursing at Fort Kent and Aroostook State Colleges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Associate degree in nursing at Fort Kent and Aroostook State Colleges. The State Board of Education at Fort Kent State College and Aroostook State College shall establish courses of study which will result in a 2-year associate degree in nursing and shall confer upon those who satisfactorily complete such courses of study such associate degree in nursing. Such courses of study shall be sufficient, together with one-year clinical training, to enable the holder of such degree to qualify to take the examination prescribed by the State Board of Nursing for applicants to practice professional nursing.

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$64,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$65,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
