AN ACT Changing the Uniform Local Effort Rate in Computing General Education Purpose Aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 3722, amended. The first sentence of Table I of section 3722 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 4 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The per pupil allowance used in computing the foundation program shall be ~~\$255~~ \$320.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, § 3723, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 3723 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

From each unit's foundation program, as defined in sections 3721 and 3722, shall be subtracted the yield of ~~20~~ 18 mills times the unit's state valuation.

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 1968.
