STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Placing State Highway Department Employees on the Merit Service Step System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Highway Department employees place on the merit service step system. The State Personnel Board is directed to amend the Compensation Plan of the State of Maine, as provided for in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 634, so that classified employees of the State Highway Department will be on the merit step system, as follows:

Highway Maintenanceman I — Pay Grade 2,	Step E
Highway Maintenanceman II — Pay Grade 4,	Step E
Highway Maintenanceman IIa — Pay Grade 5,	Step E
Highway Maintenanceman III — Pay Grade 7,	Step E
Highway Maintenanceman IV ———————————————————————————————————	Step E
Highway Foreman I — Pay Grade 14,	Step B
Highway Foreman II — Pay Grade 16,	Step E

It is the intent of the Legislature that employees in the above-named classification who presently have probationary or permanent status, enter the merit step system at the grades and rates listed above, plus such longevity step or steps as may be applicable. New employees shall start at the first step of the appropriate grade, and shall receive increases as provided for in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 634.
