AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officials of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 and section 2 of chapter 477, both of the public laws of 1965, which relates to Hancock County, is further amended to read as follows:

Hancock County: County commissioners, \$1,450; clerk of courts, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$2,850; county attorney, ~~\$5,000~~ \$5,500; county treasurer, ~~\$2,600~~ \$3,100; sheriff, \$4,750; register of deeds, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,500; judge of probate, ~~\$4,500~~ \$5,000; register of probate, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,500.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the office of Attorney General the sum of \$250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, to provide for the increase in the salary of County Attorney under this Act.
