#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Clarifying the Law Relating to Serving Liquor to Minors in the Home.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 1058, amended. Section 1058 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 143 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

## § 1058. Furnishing liquor to certain persons prohibited

Whoever knowingly procures or in any way aids or assists in procuring liquor or whoever furnishes, gives or delivers liquor to a minor who may not legally purchase liquor for himself or for any intoxicated person, pauper, mentally ill person or person of known intemperate habits, except that this provision shall not apply to liquor served to a minor in the his home in the presence of a parent or guardian, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.
