IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Public Place Under Public Drinking Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 17, § 2003, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2003 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Public place defined. "Public place" as used in this section shall mean any common carrier, dance, entertainment, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith or any highway, street or lane, or other place, to which the public is invited or has access.
