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**AN ACT Relating to Certificates Required by Railroads as Common Carriers.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., T. 35, § 1560, sub-§ 1, ¶ K, additional.** Subsection 1 of section 1560 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph K, as follows :

**K. Of any railroad common carrier while transporting freight between points and places in the territory served by said railroad provided that schedules of all rates, tolls and charges for such transportation shall be filed with the commission, as provided in chapter 3 and provided that the rules and regulations of the commission relating to safety under section 1558 shall apply to such operations, and provided that interchange of freight shall be restricted to other railroad common carriers.**
