AN ACT Relating to Approval of Pay to Cumberland County Probation Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1957, c. 387, § 34-C, amended. The first paragraph of section 34-C of chapter 387 of the public laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

The salaries of said juvenile probation officer, assistant juvenile probation officer, and probation clerk shall be determined by the Judge of the ~~municipal court for the city of Portland~~ **District Court of the 9th district** with the approval of a Judge of the Superior Court resident in Cumberland County or of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court. All of said salaries ~~shall be subject to the further approval of the county commissioners for said County of Cumberland,~~ and shall be payable monthly in equal installments by the county treasurer of the County of Cumberland upon warrants drawn by the county commissioners of said county.
