STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Approval of Pay to Cumberland County Probation Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1957, c. 387, § 34-C, amended. The first paragraph of section 34-C of chapter 387 of the public laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

The salaries of said juvenile probation officer, assistant juvenile probation officer, and probation clerk shall be determined by the Judge of the municipal court for the eity of Portland District Court of the 9th district with the approval of a Judge of the Superior Court resident in Cumberland County or of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court. All of said salaries shall be subject to the further approval of the county commissioners for said County of Cumberland, and shall be payable monthly in equal installments by the county treasurer of the County of Cumberland upon warrants drawn by the county commissioners of said county.
