**AN ACT Relating to Disability Compensation for Members of Maine
State Guard.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 883, repealed and replaced. Section 883 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 883. Active service; pay and allowances

All of sections 703, 708 and 1041 shall apply to and govern the Maine State Guard.

No pay will be allowed the officers and enlisted men of the Maine State Guard for drill and inspections, but nothing in this section shall be construed as to invalidate the provisions of section 1041 which are applicable to the Maine State Guard.
