STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Opening and Closing Time for Polls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 741, sub-§ 1, repealed and replaced. Subsection 1 of section 741 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
 - 1. Opening time fixed. The polls must be opened at 8 a.m. on election day.
- Sec. 2, R. S., T. 21, § 741, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 741 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 108 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:
- 2. Closing time fixed. The polls must be closed at & p.m. 9 p.m. on election day. The polls must remain open in each municipality until & p.m. 9 p.m. unless each registered voter of the municipality has voted.
 - A. Exceptions. In any municipality, the municipal officers may permit the polls to remain open till 9 p.m. on election day in a voting place which uses voting machines exclusively.
