STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Bullfights.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, c. 30, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter 30, as follows:

CHAPTER 30 BULLFIGHTS

§ 711. Bullfights prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person to promote, advertise, stage, hold, manage, conduct, participate in, engage in or carry on any bullfight exhibition, any bloodless bullfight, contest or exhibition, or any mock bullfight or similar contest or exhibition, whether for amusement or gain or otherwise. Any person violating this section shall, upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than \$500, or by both.
