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**AN ACT Relating to Eminent Domain Under Urban Renewal Proceedings.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 30, § 4807, amended.** The first sentence of the 5th paragraph of section 4807 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Any owner of, or persons entitled to any estate in or interest in any part of the real property, or interest therein, so taken, who cannot agree with said authority for the price of the real property, or interest therein, so taken in which he is interested as aforesaid, may, within 3 months after personal notice of said taking, or, if he has no personal notice, may within one year from the first publication of the copy of such resolution and statement referred to in the preceding paragraph, apply by complaint to the Superior Court in and for the county, setting for the taking of his real property, or interest therein, and praying for an assessment of damages by a jury or referee or referees appointed by the court.
