STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Making Juvenile Hearings Involving Alleged Crimes Under Title 17
Open to Public.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 2609, amended. Section 2609 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end thereof, the following sentence:

Juvenile hearings involving juveniles brought into juvenile court for a 2nd or subsequent offense, involving violation of Title 17, shall be public and heard in the district courtroom and the name of such juvenile shall be made public as in any other criminal matter coming before the District Court.
