STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Taking Jurisdiction of Alleged Homicides from the Juvenile Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 2522, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2552 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Juvenile courts shall have no jurisdiction over offenses in which any juvenile is charged with the violation of any provision of Title 29 or over any other traffic law or ordinance, if such offense is a misdemeanor, except that juvenile courts shall have exclusive, original jurisdiction over offenses in which any juvenile is charged with a violation of Title 29, sections 900 and 1312 1315 and 1316. Juvenile courts shall have no jurisdiction over offenses in which any juvenile is charged with the violation of Title 17, sections 2551 and 2651.
