# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Number of and Compensation for Ballot Clerks During Recounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 1152, sub-§ 11, additional. Section 1152 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 11, to read as follows:

11. Number and compensation during recounts. The ballot clerks used by the candidates involved in recounts under this subchapter shall be paid a reasonable compensation as determined by the Secretary of State.

A. Where only 2 candidates are involved, in the case of a recount for a statewide office, the maximum number of ballot clerks for which the State shall pay shall be 10 for each candidate.

B. Where only 2 candidates are involved, in the case of a recount for a congressional office, the maximum number of ballot clerks for which the State shall pay shall be 8 for each candidate.

C. Where only 2 candidates are involved, in the case of a recount for a county office, the maximum number of ballot clerks for which the State shall pay shall be 6 for each candidate.

D. Where only 2 candidates are involved, in the case of a recount for representative class districts, the maximum number of ballot clerks for which the State shall pay shall be 4 for each candidate. E. In all recounts in which more than 2 candidates are involved, the maximum number of ballot clerks for which the State shall pay shall be determined by the Secretary of State.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Secretary of State the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
