**AN ACT Relating to Pension Adjustments for Former and Present Members of
the Lewiston Police Department.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 25-B, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 25-B, to read as follows:

Sec. 25-B. Pension adjustment. Pensions being paid to former members of the Lewiston police department under section 25-A shall be adjusted in accordance with the following tabulation:

Date of retirement:	Pension increased by:
January 1, 1945 through December 31, 1950	25%
January 1, 1951 through December 31, 1955	20%
January 1, 1956 through December 31, 1960	15%
January 1, 1961 through December 31, 1966	10%
January 1, 1967 and subsequent	

On any and all future general adjustments in Lewiston police department salaries, the same percentage increase or decrease shall be applied to benefits being received by all retired members of the department or, when applicable, their beneficiaries.
