**AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Members of Lewiston Police Department.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 25-C, additional.** Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 25-C, to read as follows:

**Sec. 25-C. System of retirement benefits.** Notwithstanding other provisions of this charter to the contrary, there is provided a system of retirement benefits for members of the police department, in lieu of the retirement benefits otherwise provided for city employees, of  $\frac{1}{2}$  salary after having completed 25 years of service, which benefits shall be provided for by participation in the Maine State Retirement System, such benefits to be based on the annual rate of salary being paid at point of retirement, and without regard to minimum age for retirement. When base annual salaries of active members are increased, the retirement benefits of those already retired shall be adjusted accordingly and such adjustment shall be effective as of the date such increases are granted to active members.
