## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Disabled Members of the Lewiston Police Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 21-B, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 21-B, to read as follows:

Sec. 21-B. Pensions. The permanent nonservice-connected disability of an active member of the department with at least 19 years of service shall entitle said member to retire and receive pension benefits as follows:

19 years of service	35%	01	last	pay
20, 21 or 22 years of service	40%	of	last	pay
23 or 24 years of service	45%	of	last	pay
25 or more years of service	50%	of	1ast	pav
