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**AN ACT Relating to Appeals from Juvenile Court Proceedings.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 15, § 2662, amended.** Section 2662 of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**§ 2662. Record on appeal**

When notice is given of an appeal from the juvenile court's adjudication that a juvenile has committed a juvenile offense, the juvenile court shall **forthwith** deliver the record of proceedings in the juvenile court to the Superior Court in the same manner and form as in appeals from the District Court in criminal cases.
