AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Certain Names by Partnerships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 31, § 6, additional. Title 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 6, to read as follows:

§ 6. Prohibition of certain names

No person or persons, partnership or other entity engaged in any business, except a corporation, shall adopt a name for such business which contains the words "corporation", "incorporated" or "limited", or any abbreviation of any such words.
