COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 602, L.D. 846, Bill, "An Act Relating to Time Limit of Keeping Sick or Injured Dogs by Agency Boarding Such Dogs."

Amend said Bill in the 6th line (4th line in L.D. 846)
by striking out the underlined figure "7" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined figure '14'; and by striking out in the
7th line (5th line in L.D. 846) the figure "\$1" and inserting
in place thereof the following: '\$1 \$1.50'; and by striking out
in the 12th line (10th line in L.D. 846) the underlined figure
"7" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '14'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the Statement of Facts, the following underlined sentence: 'No dog shall leave any boarding agency until licensed by the person accepting said dog in accordance with section 3451.'
