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**AN ACT Relating to Attendance in Schools of Children of Real  
Estate Taxpayers.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 20, § 473, sub-§ 8, amended.** Subsection 8 of section 473 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**8. Determine those to attend each school.** Determine what description of scholars shall attend each school, classify them and transfer them from school to school where more than one school is kept at the same time, **except that permission shall be granted for children of real estate taxpayers to attend school in the administrative unit where the real estate is located;**
