COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 339, L. D. 372, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Protection of Corporate Name of Corporations Excused
or Suspended."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in L. D. 872)
the following underlined sentence:

'When an excused or suspended corporation votes to resume
business, it shall adopt a new name if another corporation has
adopted its old name or if the old name so nearly resembles the
name of another corporation as to be a colorable imitation thereof.'
