STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Protection of Corporate Name of Corporations Excused or Suspended.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13, § 74, amended. Section 74 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 67 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

This section shall not apply to the names of any duly excused corporation on or after the 5th anniversary of such excuse, provided such corporation was excused after December 31, 1967, or to the name of any corporation the charter of which is suspended on or after the 3rd anniversary of such suspension, provided such suspension occurred after December 31, 1967.
