STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Gasoline and Heating Oils from Being Transported in Same Tank Truck.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2441-A, additional. Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2441-A, to read as follows:

§ 2441-A. Gasoline and heating oils

It shall be unlawful to transport internal combustion engine fuel as defined in Title 36, section 2902, subsection 3, and oil used for cooking and heating in homes in the same motor truck at the same time for home delivery.
